Year 4 TRAINING BAND

The Year 4 Training Band will start next <u>MONDAY, 13 FEBRUARY</u> at <u>8.30am</u> in our school's hall. This will be a one-off, special longer start-up session. If your child is using a school hire instrument it will be issued on this day. A parent information session will be held at 10.30am on this day which will include a small concert to allow parent to witness the amazing progress the band has made later in the year.

Please note that that regular rehearsal time will be **7.45am-9.00am each Monday morning** <u>starting</u> <u>February 20.</u>

We trust that students will find their band experience as exciting and fulfilling as previous years' band members.

Year 5 OC TRAINING BAND

This is a small group of OC students who are new to our school and are enthusiastic about learning music. They will join with the Year 4 Training Band for the start-up session on Monday 13 February from 8.30am. Parents are also encouraged to attend the information session being held at 10.30am, which will include a small concert.

REHEARSAL DROP OFFS

Students should arrive at tutorials 10 minutes prior to their starting time to allow for setting up their instruments. Thank you for your support in this matter.

As you are aware, practising at home is crucial to becoming a good musician. Each student is required to do a **minimum of 60 minutes** per week. Tutors will be recording times at tutorials each week.
