Questions you might have

Why are the K-2 students coming out from different gates?

We need to help parents keep a physical distance on the street, so by sending the students out different gates will help this.

What if I have children in K-2 in different grades?

We suggest you pick up the youngest child first. If you have older children in 3-6 ask them to also go to the youngest child's designated gate.

We have chosen to go by grades rather than having gates designated for different letters of the alphabet. This will keep the children with their class teacher and provide greater safety in knowing who is picking up children.

What happens if it rains?

We are still working on this one!

Can another parent, or family member, pick up my child?

Yes. If it is a regular thing, please let the teacher know, so they feel comfortable with the handover arrangements. If you have a current arrangement already in place that is sufficient.

If it is a one off thing, please let the school know before 2pm.

What happens if my child/children ride their bikes or walk home or walk to the station?

That's fine. They will be released at 3:10pm.
